


Funding Challenges

- The OTIA and JTA programs were frontloaded and will involve significant debt service
- State Highway Fund revenue is down significantly from previous estimates
- Agency operations costs have grown faster than State Highway Fund resources
- Federal funding at risk of being cut





ODOT Highway Fund Debt Service



Portion of ODOT's Gross State Highway Fund Resources Going to Debt Service









State Highway Fund Revenue Projections for 2008-2015
